

# SRB Board\* Member recruitment process



#### LAUNCH

The European Commission (EC) launches the recruitment process, publishing vacancy notices in the Official Journal of the European Union.





The EC carries out a pre-selection of candidates, including assessing the applications and carrying out interviews. It also hears the views of the SRB Plenary Session on the potential candidates.

### 3 PROPOSAL



The EC, though a decision of the College of Commissioners, proposes a shortlist of candidates to the European Parliament (EP).

#### 4 APPROVAL



The EP carries out hearings with the candidates and submits the proposal to the Council

#### 5 APPOINTMENT



Once the European Parliament approves the candidates, the Council adopts an implementing decision to appoint the Board Member.

## 6 TAKING UP DUTIES



The Board Member takes up their duties after entry into force of the Council decision for five years. The term shall not be renewable

\*The Board is composed of the Chair, Vice-Chair and all four further full-time members of the Board
